## Yarn needed:

 RED HEART ${ }^{\star}$ Super Saver ${ }^{\circledR} 1$ skein each 0625 Guava, 0520 Minty, and 0326 Oatmeal or colors of your choice
## Tools needed:

- Susan Bates ${ }^{\circledR}$ Crochet Hook - 5.5 mm [US I-9]
- Yarn needle


## Gauge:

$12 \mathrm{dc}=$ about $4^{\prime \prime}[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ 6 rounds = about 4" [10 cm ].

## Single Square Coasters

Granny squares are a staple crochet design because they're fun to make and timeless! Practice your granny square skills and make this set of coasters!

Project size: One coaster measures about $5 \times 5$ " $[12.5 \times 12.5 \mathrm{~cm}]$.

## PATTERN

## Pattern Notes

1. Each coaster is worked in joined rounds from the center outwards.
2. For a set of six coasters, make two coasters in each of the three yarn colors.

## COASTER

Make a slip knot and place it on the hook.


Chain 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.


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Round 1: Chain 3 (counts as first dc), work 2 double crochet (dc) in ring, [chain 3, work 3 double crochet in ring] three times chain 3; join with slip st in top of beginning chain-3 - you will have four groups of 3-dc each with chain-3's between the groups.



Round 2: Slip st in next 2 dc, slip st in first ch-3 space, ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), work ( $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch}$ $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all in same (first) ch-3 space (first corner made), * work (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) all in next ch-3 space (next corner made); repeat from * 2 more times; join with slip st in top of beginning chain-3Four (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc ) corners.


Round 3: Slip st in next 2 dc , slip st in first ch-3 space, ch 3, work (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) all in same (first) corner ch-3 space work 3 dc in the next space between 3-dc groups, * work ( 3 dc, ch 3,3 dc) all in next corner ch-3 space, work 3 dc in the next space between 3 -dc groups; repeat from * 2 more times; join with slip st in top of beginning chain-3 Four ( $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{ch} 3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) corners and one 3 -dc group along each side of square between corners.


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Round 4: Slip st in next 2 dc , slip st in first ch-3 space, ch 3, work (2 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) all in same (first) corner ch-3 space, work 3 dc in each of the next 2 spaces between 3 -dc groups, * work (3 dc, ch $3,3 \mathrm{dc}$ ) all in next corner ch-3 space, work 3 dc in each of the next 2 spaces between 3-dc groups; repeat from * 2 more times; join with slip st in top of beginning chain- 3 - Four ( 3 dc, ch 3, 3 c) corners and two 3-dc group along each side of square between corners.


Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Using yarn needle, weave in yarn tails.



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
