Crochet Little Chick

YOU'LL NEED:

Loops & Threads* Soft Classic™ (100% Acrylic: 198 gm/ 354 yds):

- 1 ball MC: Butter (10228177) • 1 ball - CC: Clay (10632150)
- 1 Loops & Threads® Knit Quick™ Plastic Needles (10228237)
- 1 Loops & Threads* Anodized Aluminum Crochet Hook, US Size G (4.5 mm) (10233541)
- 1 Loops & Threads® Ball Point Pins (10340373)
- 1 Loops & Threads* Carabiner Stitch Markers, 20 ct (10)54)96)
- 1 Poly-fil* Premium Fiber Fill Bag, 12 oz (10509850)

Scrap black thread to embroider eyes and nose

ABBREVIATIONS:

Beg = (Begin)ning

CC = Contrast Color

Ch = Chain Dec'd = Decreased

MC = Main Color

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Sc = Single Crochet

SI st(s) = Slip Stitch(es)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Circumference: 9½" [24 cm]

Height: 5½" [14 cm]

GAUGE: 20 sc x 20 rnds = 4" [10 cm]; save time a nd check your gauge

PATTERN NOTES:

When working in continuous rounds, place a marker in last stitch to indicate end of the round. Move marker up as each round ends.

Inv-dec (invisible single crochet decrease): Insert hook in front loop only of each of next 2 sts, yarn over and draw through both sts, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (1 st dec'd).

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Body

With MC, make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: Into the Magic Ring work 6 sc, place removable marker in the last sc to mark end of rnd - 6 sc. Do not join, beg working in continuous rnds.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around - 12 sc.

Rnd 3: *Sc in next sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around - 18 sc.

Rnd 4: *Sc in next 2 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around - 24 sc.

Rnd 5: *Sc in next 3 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around - 30 sc.

Rnd 6: *Sc in next 4 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around - 36 sc.

Rnd 7: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 8: *Sc in next 5 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around - 42 sc.

Rnds 9: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 10: *Sc in next 6 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from * around - 48 sc.

Rnds 11-20: Sc in each sc around.

Thread the starting tail through the tapestry needle and pull it through the center of the magic ring to create the tuft on top of head. **Rnd 21:** *Sc in next 6 sc, inv-dec; rep from * around - 42 sc.

Rnd 22: *Sc in next 5 sc, inv-dec; rep from * around - 36 sc.

Rnd 23: *Sc in next 4 sc, inv-dec; rep from * around - 30 sc.

Begin stuffing Body.

Rnd 24: *Sc in next 3 sc, inv-dec; rep from * around - 24 sc.

Rnd 25: *Sc in next 2 sc, inv-dec; rep from * around - 18 sc.

Rnd 26: *Sc in next sc, inv-dec; rep from * around - 12 sc.

Finish stuffing firmly.

Rnd 27: Inv-dec around - 6 sc.

Thread tail through sts of last rnd and pull to close opening.

Beak

With CC, ch 3.

Row 1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook, dc in next ch. Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew.

Feet (make 2)

With CC, make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: Into the magic ring work 6 sc, place removable marker in the last sc to mark end of rnd - 6 sc. Do not join, beg working in continuous rnds.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around - 12 sc.

Rnd 3: *Ch 3, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next ch, sl st in next st of Rnd 2; rep from * 2 more times. Fasten off, leave a long tail to sew.

Wings (make 2)

Work Rnds 1-5 same as Body. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through tapestry needle, fold circle in half and seam edges of Rnd 5 together, forming a half-circle.

FINISHING:

Using photo as a guide, with scrap black yarn, embroider the eyes between rounds 9-10 with 7-8 sts between. Using photo as a guide, sew on Beak, Feet and Wings. Trim tuft. Weave in all ends.

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
