Small Crochet Pumpkin Pattern

Abbreviations:

Ch Chainsl st Slip Stitchst(s) Stitches

sc Single Crochet

Supplies:

Impeccable yarn by Loops & Threads Crochet Hook – US J (6mm) or similar

Stitch Marker Tapestry Needle Burlap Ribbon Hot Glue Gun Fiber Fill



Steps to make pumpkin beginning at the top:

Begin ch 6
Join with a sl st in the first st to form a loop
Round 1: sc 12 times inside the loop (for a total of 12 sts)
Round 2: *sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc* 6 times (for a total of 18 sts)
Round 3: *sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc* 6 times (for a total of 24 sts)
Round 4: *sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc* 6 times (for a total of 30 sts)
Round 5: *sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc* 6 times (for a total of 36 sts)
Rounds 6 - 12: sc in ne sc (36 sts per round)
Round 13: *Dec, Sc in next 4 sc* 6 times (for a total of 30 sts)
Round 14: *Dec, sc in next 3 sc* 6 times (for a total of 24 sts)
Round 15: *Dec, sc in next 2 sc* 6 times (for a total of 18 sts)
Tightly stuff the pumpkin with fiberfill
Round 16: *Dec, sc in next 1 sc* 6 times (for a total of 12 sts)
Round 17: *Dec, until the hole is closed

Assembly

Finish and tuck in tail.

	Step 1: Cut 6 pieces of yarn, each 10 inches long from the pumpkin yarn
	Step 2: Thread a piece of 10 inch yarn on the plastic tapestry needle. Thread the needle from the base of
	the pumpkin up to the base of the stem and pull until the center point of the yarn is at the stem. Weave
	the needle through the holes made by the decrease stitches at the base of the pumpkin.
	Step 3: Repeat Step 2 five more times
	Step 4: Holding the ends to a single 10" piece of yarn, tighten to sculpt the pumpkin indentations, then tie
	the ends int a knot at the base of the pumpkin.
	Step 5: Repeat Step 4 for the remaining 10" pieces of yarn, working opposite sides of the pumpkin for
	optimum sculpting results.
