

## Materials:

Posh Purl™ Yarn by Loops & Threads® (blush)  
Posh Purl™ Yarn by Loops & Threads® (black)  
Posh Purl™ Yarn by Loops & Threads® (white)  
Anodized Crochet Hook Set by Loops & Threads®, E-J  
Jumbo Locking Stitch Markers by Loops & Threads™  
Sewing Scissors Set by Loops & Threads®  
Premium Metals Gold Keyring Lobsters by Bead Landing™  
Plastic Needles by Creatology™

## Instructions:

Select your bow color and create a slip knot.

**Row 1** ch 15

**Row 2** ch 1 and sc in each stitch (15 sts)

**Row 3** ch 1 and sc in each stitch (15 sts)

**Row 4** ch 1 and sc in each stitch (15 sts)

Secure and leave 6 inch tail for sewing. Fold the rectangle in half so the short ends meet, then sew those ends together to form a tube- this will create the two loops of the bow. Tie several knots and weave in any remaining tails.

To create the tails of your bow

**Row 1** ch 15

**Row 2** ch 1 and sc in each stitch (15 sts)

**Row 3** ch 1 and sc in each stitch (15 sts)

**Row 4** ch 1 and sc in each stitch (15 sts)

secure and weave in both ends.

Assembly:

Stack the bow (tube) on the center of the rectangle you made for the tails of your bow. Take a piece of the same color yarn and wrap several times around the center, leaving a bit of yarn at the beginning and end to tie a knot and secure the wrap.

Add keychain by sliding keyring through some of the yarn on the back of the bow, or by tying another piece of yarn around the center and securing with knots on the back of the bow.



## Abbreviations:

ch = chain

sl = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

sc = single crochet
