Beginner Stringing
1 Hour Class


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Create a beautifully strung, flowy necklace of black diamond glass and eath tones with Czech crystal rounds.

Abbreviations:
S8 = Size 8/0 Czech Seed Bead
R6 $=6 \mathrm{~mm}$ Round Czech Crystal

Step 1
Cut 50 inches of waxed, micro-macrame cord and apply glue to the tips. This will firm the ends, making beads easier to string. Let dry.

## Step 2

Leave a 10 -inch tail. String (20)S8, selecting for metallic gold color from the Topaz Mix. String the following repeating pattern: (1) Czech glass bead, (1)S8, (1)R6, (1)S8. String this pattern until you have used the entire strand of Czech glass beads, then string (20)S8. Select each Czech glass bead in the order it is strung on the retail card.

Step 3
String (1)S8 in the dark topaz color. Go back through a few of the S8 strung in Step 2. Tie two half-hitch knots along the way, going through the next S8 between each knot. Apply a small amount of glue to the last knot and go through another S8. Trim excess cord. On the tail side, repeat this step with the tail thread.

Step 4
Open a 5 mm jump ring. Connect the dark topaz S 8 to a lobster claw clasp. Repeat on the other side with a 5 mm jump ring.

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
