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Introduction

Daisy chain jewelry and millifiore beads are timeless and universally appealing. Together in a jewelry design with pearl colored seed beads makes these designs over-the-top gorgeous! In class we will show two styles: spaced and close daisy chains. In each case the steps to make the daisy will be familiar and easy. Enjoy this fun spin on the classic daisy chain!

In this design, many colors of size 8/0 seed beads are used. The main color is white pearl, with a pop of yellow, but in both designs other colors of flower petals are introduced by changing up the seed bead color.

In the diagrams S8A is Size 8/0 White Pearl S8B is Size 8/0 Fuchsia (Petal) S8C is Size 8/0 Yellow


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Step 1 - Making the Daisies

Cut a length of beading thread comfortable to you. Thread on a size 11 beading needle. Fold over the top portion of the thread from the needle.


Leaving a 10-inch tail, string (6)S8B. Go back through the first S8B.

String (1)S8C. Skip the next two S8B and go through the third S8B.




Close Daisies

To make the close daisy design, as featured on the cover, string on a millifiore bead. Repeat Step 1, then string another millifiore bead. Repeat to desired length. Join a jump ring to the edge petal bead, Weave to reinforce. Follow the thread path through the beads or tie a half hitch knot to finish and trim thread.



Spaced Daisies

Almost the same method as close daisies, you can create with the addition of (3)S8A in between adding a new daisy or millifiore bead. The method to complete the jump ring attachment is the same. Finish with a clasp, chain and a tassel!



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
