## CORAL REPEAT BRACELET

# Show your love for Mother Earth with this beautiful macrame bracelet perfect for wearing both to the pool or for a fancy occasion. 

## Materials:

- RePEaT BRAID 1.0MM CORAL 5M (Item \#10720271)
- Silver Metal Small Cube Beads, 4 mm by Bead Landing ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (Item \# 10472568)
- Black Jasper Round Beads, 10mm by Bead Landing ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ (Item \# 10665963)

Tools:

- Tying Station (Item \# 177095601431035910) or clip board and binder clip
- Scissors
- Thread Burner or Beadalon ${ }^{\circledR}$ WildFire Cord Cutter (Item \# D521863S)


## Instructions:

Step 1 - Cut one piece of coral RePEat Cord 20 inches $(51 \mathrm{~cm})$ long and one piece of coral RePEat 6 feet ( 1.83 m ) long. Secure the shorter piece between the two plates of the Beadalon Tying Station or in a clip board with a binder clip on the bottom.

Step 2 - Fold the longer RePEat cord in half, and secure it to the middle of the shorter cord with a Lark's Head knot.
Step 3 - Create a " $P$ " with one side of the long cord over the base cord. Take the cord behind and up through the " $P$ " shape that you created and pull the cord tight.

Step 4 - Repeat Step 3 but place the cord under the base cord and take the cord behind and up through the " $\mathrm{P}^{\prime \prime}$ shape. Pull the cord tight.

Step 5 - Repeat steps 3 and 4 a total of 9 times.
Step 6 - Remove the cords from the Tying Station and arrange them so that the knotted portion is secured around the top peg of the Tying Station.
Step 7 - Use the working cords to tie 4 square macrame knots over the base cords together.
Step 8 - Thread one silver metal cube bead onto each of the working cords.
Step 9 - Tie 2 square macrame knots over the base cords together.
Step 10 - Repeat steps 8 and 9 until the bracelet is the length you'd like, minus about . 5 inches ( 12.7 mm ).
Step 11 - Tie 4 square macrame knots over the base cords together.
Step 12 - String on a 10 mm bead and tie an overhand knot to secure it in place.
Step 13 - Use a thread burner or WildFire Cord Cutter to trim and seal the ends.
