

MULTISTRAND BRACELET

A multi-strand bracelet is a great way to use up leftover beads from other projects, or create a stunning design to complement any outfit.

Materials:

- Beadalon® 0.46mm Bright 19 Strand Bead Stringing Wire, 60ft. - Item # 10720292
- Crimp Beads Variety Pack Size 1 600/Pkg-Silver-, Gold-, Copper- & Black-Plated - Item # 181822190141374485
- Wire Guards by Bead Landing™ - Item # 10697674
- Gold-Plated Crimp Covers-4mm 20/Pkg - Item # 181016140744032274
- Multi-Strand Connectors by Bead Landing™ - Item # 10698057

Beads:

- Freshwater Pearl Rice Beads, 5mm by Bead Landing™ - Item # 10467298
- Amber Small Glass Faceted Rondel Beads, 3mm by Bead Landing™ - Item # 10471957
- Champagne Faceted Glass Round Beads by Bead Landing™ - Item # 10594095

Instructions:

Step 1 - Lay out your design on the Bead Board.

Step 2 - Cut 5 pieces of Beadalon Beading Wire, 10 in (25 cm) long.

Step 3 - Place a Bead Stopper on one end of each wire.

Step 4 - String up your pattern of beads onto each of the 5 wires.

Step 5 - Remove one of the Bead Stoppers and add a crimp tube and wire guardian to the wire. Thread onto the first loop of the Multi-Strand Connector. Thread your wire back through the crimp tube. Snug up the wire around the connector, and use Crimping Pliers to crimp the crimp tube. Repeat to add the other strung wires to each of the loops of the connector.

Step 6 - Repeat Step 5 to secure the 5 strands to a second Multi-Strand Connector. Make sure that you don't get any of the strands crossed and the connectors are facing the right way.

Step 7 - Add a crimp cover over each of the crimp tubes if desired.

Step 8 - Use jump rings to attach the clasp.
