CROCHET ROSIE WREATH





Crochet Rosie Wreath

YOU'LL NEED:

Soft Classic™ Solid Yarn by Loops & Threads® (100% Acrylic: 198 gm/ 354 vds);

- 1 ball Light Pink (10626714)
- 1 ball Pink (10626713)
- 1 ball Bright Red (10196927)
- 1 Loops & Threads® Knit Quick™ Plastic Needles (10228237)
- 1 Loops & Threads® Anodized Aluminum Crochet Hook, US Size H-5 (5 mm) (10248668)
- 1 Ashland® 12" Grapevine Heart Wreath (10229891)

ABBREVIATIONS :

Beg = Begin(ning) Ch(s) = Chain(s)

Dc = Double Crochet

Dtr = Double Treble

Rep = Repeat

SI st(s) = Slip stitch(es)

Sp(s) = Space(es)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tr = Treble

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS: 11.5" [29 cm] x 12" [30.5 cm] **GAUGE:** Gauge is not crucial for this project.

NOTES:

This Wreath is made by crocheting 8 Roses and attaching them to the Wreath. Each Rose is crocheted in one row which is rolled and sewn to form its shape.

INSTRUCTIONS:

Solid Roses (make 3 in Pink, 2 in Light Pink and 2 in Bright Red)

Leaving an 20" tail, ch 49.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook, dc in next ch, ch 2, sl st in next ch, ch 3, dc in each of next 2 chs, ch 2, sl st in next ch, (ch 4, tr in each of next 4 chs, ch 3, sl st in next ch) three times, ch 4, tr in each of next 6 chs, ch 3, sl st in next ch, (ch 5, dtr in each of next 8 chs. ch 4. sl st in next ch) twice. Fasten off, leaving an 20" tail.

Ombre Roses

Follow instructions for Solid Roses, Begin with Light Pink and change to Pink at the last sI st before the first ch-4 of Row 1. Repeat for second Ombre Rose. beginning with Bright Red and changing to Light Pink.

FINISHING:

Beginning at the first stitch of the row, roll the Rose into shape. Using tapestry needle and long tails, weave through the base of the Rose to secure in place. Using photo as a guide, tie each Rose to the Wreath with the remaining lengths of tail. Tie knots as needed and weave tails through using tapestry needle to tighten. Weave in ends.

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
