

# COZY MITTENS

Skill Level: **EASY** 

Pattern: M24088D WEA



### LION BRAND® WOOL-EASE® AIRE COZY MITTENS

#### **EASY**

#### SIZE

**Adult** 

**Finished Length:** 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm)

Finished Width: 4 in. (10 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND WOOL-EASE AIRE (Art. #644)
   #134 Spicy 1 ball
- LION BRAND stitch holders
- LION BRAND stitch markers
- LION BRAND large-eyed blunt needle

#### **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Double-pointed knitting needles size 5 (3.75 mm) (set of 5)

Double-pointed knitting needles size 7 (4.5 mm) (set of 5)

#### **GAUGE**

16 sts = about 4 in. [10 cm] in St st worked in rnds (k every rnd) with larger needles.
BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### STITCH PATTERN

## K1, p1 Rib (worked in rnds over an even number of sts)

Rnd 1: \*K1, p1; rep from \* around. Repeat Rnd 1 for K1, p1 Rib worked in rnds.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION

**M1 (make 1)** An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop – 1 st increased.

### MITTENS (make 2)

#### Cuff

With smaller needles, cast on 28 sts. Divide sts evenly onto 4 needles (7 sts on each of the 4 needles), and join, being careful not to twist sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd. Work in k1, p1 Rib worked in rnds until rib measures about 3 in. (7.5 cm).

Change to larger needles and work in St st worked in rnds (k every rnd) for 3 rnds.

#### **Shape thumb**

**Note:** You'll now work increases to begin shaping the thumb.

**Rnd 1:** K13, M1, k to end of rnd - 29 sts.

**Rnd 2:** K13, place marker, k3, place marker, k to end.

**Rnd 3:** K to first marker, slip marker, k1, M1, k1, M1, k1, slip marker, k to end of rnd - 5 sts between markers.

Rnd 4: Knit.

**Rnd 5:** K to first marker, slip marker, k1, M1, k to 1 st before next marker, M1, k1, slip marker, k to end of rnd.

Rnd 6: Knit.

Rep Rnds 5 and 6 until you have 15 sts between markers.

**Next Rnd:** K to first marker, remove marker, k1, slip next 13 sts to a holder, k1, remove marker, k to end of rnd – 28 sts remain on your needles.

Work even in St st worked in rnds on 28 sts until piece measures about 9 3/4 in. (25.5 cm) from beg.

#### **Shape Top of Mitten**

**Rnd 1:** \*K5, k2tog; rep from \* around – you'll have 24 sts.

Rnds 2, 4, 6 and 8: Knit.

Rnd 3: \*K4, k2tog; rep from \* around - 20 sts.

Rnd 5: \*K3, k2tog; rep from \* around - 16 sts.

Rnd 7: \*K2, k2tog; rep from \* around - 12 sts.

Rnd 9: \*K1, k2tog; rep from \* around - 8 sts.

Rnd 10: K2tog around - 4 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Draw tail through rem sts and pull tightly together to close opening at top of Mitten.

Knot securely.

#### **Thumb**

Divide sts from holder onto 3 larger needles. From right side, pick up and k 3 sts along edge of hand, then knit remaining sts – you'll have a total of 16 sts. Place marker for beg of rnd.

Next Rnd: (K2tog, k6) twice - 14 sts.

Work even in St st worked in rnds until Thumb measures about 2 1/4 in. [5.5 cm].

Next Rnd: \*K2tog around - 7 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Draw tail through rem sts and pull tightly together to close opening at top of Thumb.

Knot securely.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in yarn ends.

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

beg = begin(ning)(s)
k = knit
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
p = purl
rep = repeat
rnd(s) = round(s)
sl = slip
st(s) = stitch(es)
St st = Stockinette stitch
