

Materials:

Cozy Cub™ Yarn by Loops & Threads®
Anodized Crochet Hook Set by Loops & Threads®, E-J
Plastic Needles by Creatology™
Sewing Scissors Set by Loops & Threads®

Instructions:

Body of Sweater

Using Color A, ch 16. Join with a sl st to the first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 Ch 1, sc in each ch of the ring. (16 sts)

Join with a sl st to the first sc. Fasten off Color A.

Rnd 2 Join Color B where you fastened off the last round.

Ch 3 (counts as first dc), dc in next 2 sts.

Skip next 4 sts. Dc in next 4 sts.

Skip next 4 sts. Dc in next 2 sts,

then dc into the same place where you joined. (10 sts)

Join with a sl st.

Rnd 3 Join Color A in space where you fastened off the last round.

Ch 3, dc in each st around and dc into the same space where you began the round. (12 sts)

Join with a sl st into the ch 3. Fasten off.

Rnd 4 Join Color B in any dc on the back of the sweater.

Ch 3, dc in each st around. (12 sts)

Join with a sl st into the ch 3. Fasten off.

Rnd 5 Join Color A in any dc on the back of the sweater.

Ch 3, dc in each st around. (12 sts)

Join with a sl st into the ch 3. Fasten off.

Sleeves

Locate the first set of 3 skipped stitches from Rnd 2 of the body of your sweater.

Join Color B in the space before the first skipped stitch.

Rnd 1 Ch 1, sc in each of the 4 skipped stitches to form a small tube.

Join with a sl st. Fasten off.

Rnd 2 Join Color A. Ch 3, dc in each st around.

Join with a sl st to beginning ch 3. Fasten off.

Repeat for Second Sleeve using the second set of 4 skipped stitches.

Finishing

Turn the sweater inside out to hide yarn tails.

Weave in or trim excess yarn.

Shape a small wire into a hanger and attach to the neckline.



Abbreviations:

ch = chain

sl = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet
