VAMPIRE

IN **3** EASY STEPS



BASE

1

With a wet sponge and white paint, cover the whole face, leaving space around the eyes.



DETAIL

2

Next paint thick black circles around the eyes. With a small brush and black paint, add thin lines leading from the black circles to form the veins.



FINISH

3

With a small brush and black paint add two curved triangles facing in towards each other at the corners of the mouth for vampire fangs. With red paint add drips of blood in the corner of the mouth and to the end of the fangs.

CAT ZOMBIE

IN 3 EASY STEPS



1

BASE

Start the cat by using your black Brush Pen to draw a spiky fur outline on the forehead, plus whiskers, brows, nose, fangs and a few shadows under the eyes.



2

DETAIL

Next twist up your white Brush Pen and fill in the areas across the cheeks and nose (avoiding the eyes), the fangs and tufts above the brows. Then you need to blend black and white Brush Pen paints together to make a dark grey colour for the brows and jawline. Blend on the back of your hand, or on a palette/plate – you can try doing it directly onto the face, but this can be a little trickier. Paint the grey inside the black lines.



3

FINISH

Lastly, add scars and blood dripping from the fangs with an orange Brush Pen. Hissssss.

MUMMY

IN 3 EASY STEPS



BASE

1

Start the Mummy by drawing thick goggle frames around the eyes with your black Brush Pen, carefully avoiding the sensitive eye area.



DETAIL

2

Next create your bandage lines with the same black Brush Pen. Draw lines across the forehead, cheeks, chin and nose and leave to dry.



FINISH

3

Finally, you just need to take a white Brush Pen, twist it up and get to work filling in the bandages. It's super easy and very effective – just be careful to avoid the Mummy's curse!

PUMPKIN

IN 3 EASY STEPS



1

BASE

Start your spooky look by drawing a pumpkin shape in black Brush Pen, complete with a curved outline, triangle eyes, a triangle nose and zigzag mouth.



2

DETAIL

Next you need to completely fill in the outline with an orange Brush Pen. Once this is done you can add some black curved lines on the forehead and cheeks to give the pumpkin its classic 3D shape.



3

FINISH

Start by taking the green Brush Pen and drawing a pumpkin stalk, outline it using the black Brush Pen. Finally, it's time to make a rainbow on the chin, as if it's pouring out of the mouth. To do this take an array of different coloured Brush Pens and paint vertical stripes. Finally, complete the look by adding little white dots in clusters of three across the surface of the pumpkin. Super spooky!

SUGAR SKULL

IN 3 EASY STEPS



1

BASE

Sponge white over the entire face. Paint thick black circles around the eyes and add a black diamond on the end of the nose. In the middle of the forehead, paint in the black flourish. Then create the 'stitch' mouth design.



2

DETAIL

Add sky blue, bright yellow and grass green tear drops and dots to the sides of the forehead. Outline the eyes in orange.



3

FINISH

Add bright red teardrops to the cheeks. Create a bright red and royal blue cobweb design on the chin. Finally, with a fine brush, outline the eyes with black and complete the chin design.

VAMPIRE

BASE

1

With a wet sponge and white paint, cover the whole face, leaving space around the eyes.



DETAIL

2

Then with a small brush and red paint, add a couple of lines for a scar on one cheek and drips of blood in the corners of the mouth.



FINISH

3

With a small brush and black paint, add triangles of black paint above the eyebrows, to create scary thick eyebrows. Add two curved triangles facing in towards each other at the corners of the mouth for vampire fangs. Fangtastic!

WITCH

IN 3 EASY STEPS



1

BASE

With a slightly wet brush and purple paint, draw two big ovals in the shape of a mask around the eyes and above the eyebrows. Make sure these meet and cover the nose and extend slightly down the cheeks. With a wet sponge fill in the shape with purple paint.



2

DETAIL

With a wet sponge and white paint dab across the top of the mask to create a lighter effect. Then with a small brush and black paint, draw and fill in a spider's body with eight legs extending to the forehead and down the nose.



3

FINISH

With a small brush and black paint, draw lines for spider webs extending from the top part of the spider legs and on each side of the cheek. With white paint add stars in the empty places in different sizes. Wow!

ZOMBIE

IN 3 EASY STEPS



1

BASE

Using a sponge, cover the face in white paint. Then, mix some white with a touch of black and dab the grey on the head, chin and cheek.



2

DETAIL

Mix some more grey and paint darker circles around the eyes. Then add some definition to the grey patch on the right cheek. Use a brush to paint a large black triangle on the left cheek, then add an arrow shape on the left temple and three lines on the right cheek.



3

FINISH

Using a thin brush and some white paint, add some crooked teeth to the black triangle on the left cheek. Then take some red paint and the corner of a sponge to blend a bit of 'blood' round the edge. Finish by painting a red 'cut' through the lines on the right cheek and a bit of dripping 'blood' on the temple.
