# Crochet Little Bunny

# YOU'LL NEED:

Loops & Threads\* Chenille Home Slim™ (100% Acrylic: 250 gm/ 218 yds):

- 1 ball MC: Rose (10697471)
- 1 ball CC1: White (10697425)
- 1 ball CC2: Black (10697450)
- 1 Loops & Threads® Knit Quick™ Plastic Needles (10228237)
- 1 Loops & Threads® Anodized Aluminum Crochet Hook US Size K (6.5 mm) (10248677)
- 1 Loops & Threads® Carabiner Stitch Markers, 20 count (10154196)
- 1 Poly-fil\* Premium Fiber Fill Bag, 12 oz (10509850)

#### ABBREVIATIONS:

Beg = (Begin)ning

CC = Contrast Color

Ch = Chain

Dec'd = Decreased MC = Main Color

Rep = Repeat Rnd(s) = Round(s)

Sc = Single Crochet

St(s) = Stitch(es)

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Circumference: 20" [51 cm]

Height: 9" [23 cm] not including ears

GAUGE: 12 sc x 10 rnds = 4" [10 cm] before stuffing; save time and check your gauge

#### PATTERN NOTES:

When working in continuous rounds, place a marker in last stitch to indicate end of the round. Move marker up as each round ends

Inv-dec (invisible single crochet decrease): Insert hook in front loop only of each of next 2 sts, yarn over and draw through both sts, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (1 st dec'd).

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1, and begin working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

#### INSTRUCTIONS:

# Body

With MC, make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: Into the magic ring work 6 sc, place removable marker in the last sc to mark end of rnd - 6 sc. Do not join, beg working in continuous rnds.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around - 12 sc.

Rnd 3: \*Sc in next sc: 2 sc in next sc: rep from \* around - 18 sc. Rnd 4: \*Sc in next 2 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around - 24

Rnd 5: \*Sc in next 3 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around -30 sc.

Rnd 6: \*Sc in next 4 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around -

Rnd 7: \*Sc in next 5 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around -42 sc.

Rnd 8: \*Sc in next 6 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around -

Rnd 9: \*Sc in next 7 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around -

Rnd 10: \*Sc in next 8 sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around -60 sc.

Rnds 11-16: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 17: \*Sc in next 8 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 54 sc. Rnd 18: \*Sc in next 7 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 48 sc.

Rnd 19: \*Sc in next 6 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 42 sc.

Rnd 20: \*Sc in next 5 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 36 sc.

Rnd 21: \*Sc in next 4 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 30 sc.

Begin stuffing Body.

Rnd 22: \*Sc in next 3 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 24 sc. Rnd 23: \*Sc in next 2 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 18 sc.

Rnd 24: \*Sc in next sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 12 sc.

Finish stuffing firmly.

Rnd 25: Inv-dec around - 6 sc

Thread tail through sts of last rnd and pull to close opening. Fasten off, weave in ends.

#### Fars (make 2)

With MC, make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: Into the magic ring work 6 sc, place removable marker in the last sc to mark end of rnd - 6 sc. Do not join, beg working in continuous rnds.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc - 12 sc.

Rnd 3: \*Sc in next sc; 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around - 18 sc. Rnds 4-7: Sc in each sc around.

Rnds 8: Sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around -21 sc.

Rnds 9-10: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 5 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 18 sc.

Rnd 12: Sc in each sc around.

Rnd 13: Sc in next 4 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 15 sc.

Rnd 14: Sc in each sc around. Rnd 15: Sc in next 3 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 12 sc. Rnd 16: Sc in each sc around, Fasten off.

#### Paws (make 2)

With MC, make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: Into the magic ring work 4 sc, place removable marker in the last sc to mark end of rnd - 4 sc. Do not join, beg working in continuous rnds.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc - 8 sc.

Rnd 3: Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around - 12 sc. Rnd 4: Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around -

Rnd 5-6: Sc in each sc around. Lightly stuff, if desired. Rnd 7: Sc in next 2 sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 12 sc.

Rnd 8: Sc in next sc, inv-dec; rep from \* around - 8 sc.

Rnd 9: Sc in each sc around. Fasten off.

# FINISHING:

Note: If desired, use a smooth yarn for easier seaming. Using photo as a guide, embroider on eye detail with CC2 on Rnd 10 about 8 stitches apart. With CC1, embroider nose detail between the Eyes. Using photo as a guide, sew Ears and Paws in place. Weave in remaining ends.

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
