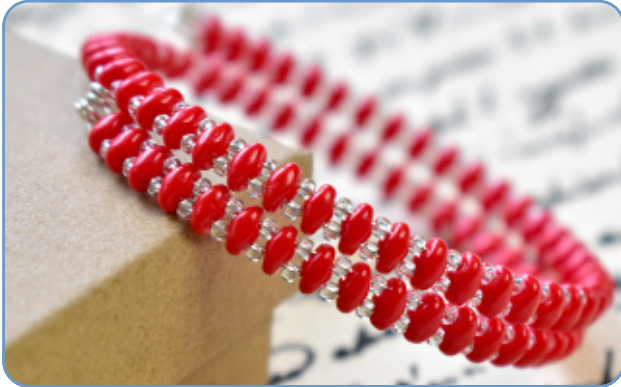


## MEMORY WIRE SUPERDUO BRACELET

SuperDuo beads aren't just for beadweaving designs! Use two coils of Beadalon Memory Wire and make an easy, fast, and beautiful bangle bracelet - no clasp required!

### Materials:

- Beadalon Round Memory Wire, Bracelet - #10376078
- John Bead Superduo Two-Hole Czech Glass Beads Item # 10627250
- John Bead Transparent Czech Glass Seed Beads, 11/0 Item # 10627227

### Tools:

- Beadalon® Standard Wire Looping Pliers Item # 10121793
- Beadalon® Slim Line Round Nose Pliers Item # D696221S
- Beadalon Memory Wire Shears - #1033239

### Instructions:

Step 1 - Cut two double rounds of Memory Wire.

Step 2 - Using wire looping and round nose pliers, create loops on one end of each piece of Memory Wire.

Step 3 - Thread one size 11 bead onto each piece of Memory Wire. Thread one SuperDuo bead onto both pieces of Memory Wire. Repeat until you reach about 3/4 inch (19mm) from each end.

Step 4 - Create a loop with the wire looping and round nose pliers on each of the end of the Memory Wire to secure the beads.

### More About Memory Wire

- Memory Wire is a full-hard steel wire that holds its round shape.
- ALWAYS use Memory Wire Shears to cut Memory Wire.
- Finish the ends of Memory Wire by turning them into a loop or glue on a Memory Wire Endcap.
- Add dangles to the loops for a fun finish.
- The size of your beads will have a big effect on the size of the finished bracelet. Bigger beads will fill up the inside diameter of the design, so you'll need to start with bigger memory wire, and vice versa.
- The weight of your beads will also determine your choice of which memory wire to choose.
- Oval Memory Wire is a great choice for bracelets that hug the natural shape of your wrist. Finish it off with a magnetic clasp for a perfect bangle.
