You're invited to an earrings party! Join us to create these trending styes in minutes using basic techniques. In class we will bring together crystal, pearls, paper clip chain, and metals to check off all the trends: chain jewelry, threader earrings, pearls, and shoulder dusters! Make these styles your own by changing up your beads and metal finishes.

Faux Threaders with Crystal! Step 1

Cut links of chain:

- (2) 1.75" long
- (2) 2.25" long


Make four

On a 1 inch ball headpin, string:

- (1) 3mm Silver Bead
- (1) 4mm Crystal
- (1) 3mm Silver Bead



Form a **simple loop** above the top bead. To do this, bend the remaining head pin wire above the top bead 90 degrees over. Trim it to 1/4". Use round nose pliers to roll a loop forward on the pliers until the end meets the top of the bead. Adjust and flatten out with chain nose pliers.



Step 2, Faux Threaders

With each of the four simple-looped crystal head pins, slide open the loop in a lateral motion using chain nose pliers. Hook each onto the end of each chain. Close the loops using that same, lateral motion.

Step 3

Open a 4mm jump ring using the same, lateral motion as with the loops. Attach the tops of the long chain to the earring clutch.

Step 4

Open the loop on the earring posts. Attach the tops of the shorter lengths of chain and close the loop.

Crystal Hoops with Chain!

Step 1 - Make two sets
Cut the following chain lengths
(or cut your desired lengths)
6 links
8 links
10 links
12 links

Select two, same-size hoops from the hoops pack, in the size of your choice. String Bicone Crystal, Link of Chain, Bicone... ending with a Bicone. String the chain in cascading order.

Step 2

Using Square Chain Nose Pliers, fold to a slight angle the end of the earring hoop. This will make it lock when worn.



Pearl Shoulder Dusters!

Step 1

Make Six

Using 1 inch eye pins, slide on a 6mm pearl and form a **simple loop** (see above).

Make Two

Using 1 inch Ball Head Pins, String on an 8mm pearl and form a **simple loop**.

Cut Six

Cut lengths of chain six links long, or approx .75"

Step 2 - Do for each earring
Using chain nose pliers, in a lateral motion, open
the loops on each of the pearls and connect them
so that you have chain in between each 6mm Pearl.



Below the last 6mm pearl, link a link of chain and an 8mm at the bottom of that.

Back at the top, link the top 6mm pearl to the earring post. Finish with earring clutches.
