

Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND® TRUBOO SPARKLE HULETT SHAWL

Pattern Number: M20329 TBS



SKILL LEVEL – EASY

SIZES

About 20 x 65 in. (51 x 165 cm)

MATERIALS

LION BRAND® TRUBOO SPARKLE (Art. #836)

#306 Sugar Cookie 2 balls (A) #300 Truffle 2 balls (B)

#303 Plum 2 balls (C)

- LION BRAND® crochet hook H-8 (5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

 $7 \text{ V-sts} + 9 \text{ rows} = \text{about } 4 \frac{1}{4} \text{ in. } (11 \text{ cm})$

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

V-st (V-stitch) (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated stitch or space.

NOTES

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows, changing yarn color to make stripes
- 2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Fasten off old color. Proceed with new color.
- 3. For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a stitch diagram.

SHAWL

With A, ch 100.

Row 1: V-st in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as 1 base ch and first dc), *sk next 2 ch, V-st in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk next ch, dc in last ch – you will have 32 V-sts, 1 dc at beg and end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, V-st in each ch-1 sp across, dc in top of beg ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 65 in. (165 cm) from beg, changing yarn color as follows:

Work 16 more rows with A.

Work 10 rows with B.

Work 8 rows with C.

Work 14 rows with A.

Work 10 rows with B.

Work 21 rows with C.

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Work 10 rows with A.

Work 7 rows with B.

Work 5 rows with C.

Work 9 rows with A.

Work 18 rows with B.

Work 10 rows with C.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
