## EASY

## SIZE

About $46 \times 56$ in. ( $117 \times 142 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), not including fringes

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® THE COTTONY ONE (Art. \#3040)
\#171 Flamingo Amber 2 balls (A)
\#152 Pewter Pan 2 balls (B)
\#130 Olive Twist 2 balls (C)
\#158 Gold Medal 2 balls (D)
\#122 Marvellous Mushroom 2 balls (E)
\#098 Lychee White 2 balls (F)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle


## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Circular knitting needle size 7 ( 4.5 mm ), 36 in . ( 90 cm ) long

## GAUGE

16 sts +31 rows = about $4 \mathrm{in} .(10 \mathrm{~cm})$ over Garter st (k every st of every row). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## NOTES

1. Throw is worked back and forth in rows of Garter st (k every st of every row).
2. Yarn color is changed to make stripes. To change yarn color, cut old color and begin knitting with new color. Leave long yarn tails to weave in later.
3. Circular needle is used to accommodate the number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on circular needle as if working with straight needles.
4. Fringes are added to finished Throw.

## THROW

With A, cast on 220 sts.
With A, work in Garter st (k every st of every row) for 59 rows.
With B, work in Garter st for 60 rows.
With C, work in Garter st for 60 rows.
With D, work in Garter st for 60 rows.
With E, work in Garter st for 60 rows.
With F, work in Garter st for 60 rows.
Bind off.

## FINISHING

## Fringe

Cut a $14 \mathrm{in} .(35.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ strand of each color yarn.
Hold strands together and fold in half.
Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of Throw, forming a loop. Pull ends of strand through this loop and pull to tighten.
Repeat to make 31 fringes evenly spaced along each side edge of Throw.
Trim fringe evenly.
Weave in ends.
